 Practice Chord Progressions and Strumming Patterns for "How Great is Our God"


#### **Quick Tips for Guitar Session**

- Third Finger Anchor On the E minor chord, you can also leave your third and fourth finger down if you want to. It still sounds great it just adds a high sparkle to the E minor chord.
- 2. Want to sing and play? Starting off singing and playing can be difficulty but don't worry... it does not come naturally to most people. When you start playing the progressions this week for How Great is Our God, you can begin to hum the melody as you are strumming. This will help you get over the awkward feeling and you will be able to start singing the words soon!
- 3. **Keep a steady rhythm!** It is very important that you start slowly with the progressions and don't break the rhythm. You won't be able to play the song if you break rhythm between chord changes. Play the progressions as slow as you need to this week so that you can play them without breaking the rhythm between changes.


